**Best presented First Ridden Pony, rider & equipment (informal)
Novice Rider (First Ridden), 0-5 wins
Open Rider under 10 years (First Ridden)
Novice First Ridden Pony, not exceeding 148cms, 0-5 wins
Open First Ridden Pony, not exceeding 128cms
Open First Ridden Pony, over 128cms & not exceeding 148cms
Champion and Reserve Champion First Ridden Pony.**

To be judged from winners of Novice and two open classes. Second place First Ridden Pony to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

**Novice paced & mannered First Ridden Pony, 0-5 wins
Open paced & mannered First Ridden Pony
First Ridden Pony over trotting poles**

Riders 4 to 7 years

Ponies to be led by an adult with a leading rein attached to the noseband of a snaffle bridle. Ponies will be asked to walk and trot only.

Best Rider 6 & 7 years
Novice Lead Rein Pony 0-5 wins

Champion and Reserve Champion Young Led Pony. To be judged from winners of three age group classes. Second place Led Pony to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

Mare, Stallion or Gelding 4 years & over - 138cms & under
Mare, Stallion or Gelding 4 years & over - over 138cms & not exceeding 148cms
Mare suitable to breed - 138cms & under
Mare suitable to breed – over 138cms & not exceeding 148cms

Champion and Reserve Champion Led Pony. To be judged from winners of the four classes. Second place Led Pony to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

Most suitable as dressage pony

LED SPORT HORSE RING

To be held after lunch – not before 12.30pm

Led Sport Horse ring
Best presented horse & handler
Yearling Colt, Gelding or Filly to mature over 148cms
2-year-old Colt, Gelding or Filly to mature over 148cms
3-year-old Colt Gelding or Filly to mature over 148cms
Champion and Reserve Champion Young Stock. To be judged from winners of 3 age group classes. Second place Young Stock to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

4-6-year-old Stallion, Gelding or Filly
Mare suitable to breed over 6 years
Gelding or Stallion – over 6 years
Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Sport Horse. To be judged from winners of 3 age group classes. Second place Senior Sport Horse to the Champion to be judged alongside the remaining winners for Reserve Champion.

Sport horse suitable as field hunter
Sport horse suitable as eventer
Sport horse suitable as park or show hack *
Sport horse suitable as show jumper
Sport horse suitable as dressage horse
Sport horse suitable as saddle hunter or riding horse *
